This half term we have conducted a range of pupil voice questionnaires. It is pleasing to report that pupils in school feel safe and confident they know who to go to if they had a concern. The pupils have a greater awareness of what 'bullying' is and report that any initial concerns are dealt with quickly and effectively. Pupils are happy and have shared positive reports about the new curriculum topics they have covered so far. Feedback about what subjects they would like to do more of and what developments they would like to see in school are collated by the school council.

The EWO will be visiting school and looking at attendance data once every 3 weeks. We as a school are keen to show that where attendance has dropped, there is an improvement and families are engaging with us as a school.
