### Water Bottles

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope this letter finds you well. Your child will come home today with their school water bottle. Starting from today, it will be the responsibility of parents and children to ensure that children bring a water bottle to school each day.

You may choose to send your child with their current school water bottle (as there is no expectation to purchase a new one) or provide one from home. Please note that the drink must be water, as per our current policy.

Please ensure your child brings their water bottle to school every day. They will have the opportunity to refill their bottles in school as normal. If you choose to keep the school water bottle in school for the week, this is fine; however, children will be encouraged to take them home each week to be washed and refreshed.

If you or your child forgets their bottle, please don't worry. There is access to water fountains, cups, and drinks at lunchtime, and your child will have the opportunity to have a drink throughout the day. There is no need to bring bottles back in once the gates have closed. Additionally, children can still bring in another bottle of squash at lunchtime if they would like if this is what they would usually do, but the bottles they access during learning time must contain water.

If you wish to discuss further, please come and speak with your child's class teacher or an adult from school.

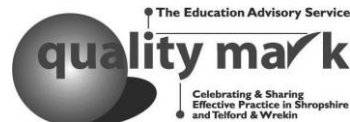
