

On the **11**<sup>th</sup> **April** your child's class will be taking part in a Scooter Skills Training session. The programme is delivered by Telford & Wrekin Council's, Road Safety & Active Travel Team.

This fun filled session teaches children basic scooter handling and control skills through a variety of games and exercises. Scooting is regarded as a core activity and can help and improve co-ordination and balance. The training will take place on the school playground and your child requires a scooter to take part in the session. (We are unable to provide scooters for this session.)
