# What does taking part involve?

On the day that I visit your child's school, your child and I will play together with some toys at a table. Following this, they will play some fun games on an iPad. In total, this will take around 20 minutes. If your child wishes to stop, then they will be free to do so at any time.

Audio-visual recordings of your child will be made while they are taking part. These will be stored securely, and only accessed by key members of our research team. For further information, please see the full information sheet.

### Does my child have to take part?

No, taking part is entirely voluntary.

### What is the research for?

This research is designed to help us understand how children learn new words and signs. We are particularly interested in learning more about the best way to teach signs, such as Makaton, to children aged 4-years. We are currently interested in children with no neurodevelopmental diagnoses. However, we hope that this research will also inform future understanding about how children with diagnoses such as Down syndrome learn signs.

### Who am I?
