Dear Parents and Guardians,

This term we will be discussing the NSPCC's talk PANTS rules in our assembly and during our PSHE lessons. During these discussions, we will aim to teach our children the following important safety skills without giving any explicit information or telling any scary stories. These are the PANTS rules:

- P: Privates are private
- A: Always remember your body belongs to you
- N: No means no
- T: Talk about secrets that upset you
- S: Speak up, someone can help

The lesson empowers children, in an age-appropriate way, to recognise their rights to their own bodies, say no to unwanted touch, and tell someone if they feel uncomfortable. The lessons include activities which help children understand:

- Appropriate and inappropriate touch
- Their right to say no to things that make them feel upset or uncomfortable
- The names for parts of the body
- Who to turn to if they ever feel upset and worried.

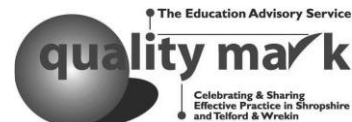
